

Dear Wildwood School Community,

Today, Thursday, Oct. 22, 2020, Wildwood was advised and has confirmed that one member of the school community has tested positive for COVID-19.

The individual who tested positive has been placed in isolation and will not return to the school until cleared by the health department.

We have been in contact with the applicable health department and it will determine and identify the individual's close contacts at the school. All attendance records, visitors' logs and employee badge swipes have been reviewed and the health department will reach out to members of the school community who were in close contact with the individual, and will also advise on the need to quarantine and to facilitate testing of those potentially exposed. It has been verified that safety protocols were in place and being followed, minimizing risks of exposure.

In order to allow our program and agency leadership sufficient time to gather all necessary information and to make appropriate plans to safeguard the health and wellbeing of our students, families and staff, **WILDWOOD SCHOOL ACTIVITIES WILL TAKE PLACE ONLY THROUGH REMOTE INSTRUCTION TOMORROW, FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2020. THERE WILL BE NO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION AT EITHER SCHOOL LOCATION ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23RD.** Please watch the school website and await further contact from your classroom teams tomorrow and over the weekend, regarding plans for next week.

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information regarding positive cases or mandatory quarantine.
