

Dear Wildwood School Community,

Today, Thursday, January 14, 2021, Wildwood was advised and has confirmed that two members of the school community have tested positive for COVID-19.

The individuals who tested positive were staff members, and will not return to the school until cleared by the health department.

We have begun contact tracing and school administration will be reaching out to members of the school community who were in close contact with that individual, and will also advise on the need to quarantine and to facilitate testing of those potentially exposed. It has been verified that safety protocols were in place and being followed, minimizing risks of exposure.

The exposure happened at Curry Road and affected Classroom 11. Wildwood School will continue to be open, utilizing our Hybrid 1 model, with the exception of those classrooms and individuals that are quarantined. Those classrooms will return to school when cleared by the health department. Classroom 11 will have their quarantine extended, and will return to school on Monday, January 25, 2021.

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information regarding positive cases or mandatory quarantine.
