

Dear Wildwood School Community,

Yesterday, Monday, January 18, 2021, Wildwood was notified late in the evening and has confirmed that one member of the school community has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual who tested positive and those who were exposed, will not return to the school until cleared by the health department.

We have begun contact tracing and school administration will be reaching out to members of the school community who were in close contact with that individual, and will also advise on the need to quarantine and facilitate testing of those potentially exposed. It has been verified that safety protocols were in place and being followed, minimizing risks of exposure.

The exposure happened at Curry Road and affected Classroom 5. Wildwood School will continue to be open, utilizing our Hybrid 1 model, with the exception of this classroom and all individuals that are quarantined. Classroom 5 students will return to school on **Tuesday, January 26, 2021**, unless otherwise notified. **Parents have been contacted directly by the School Administration. School CSE's and School Transportation Companies will receive a separate email if they are affected.**

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information regarding positive cases or mandatory quarantine.
