

Dear Wildwood School Community,

Today, Sunday, January 24, 2021, Wildwood was informed and confirmed that one member of the school community has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual who tested positive and those who were exposed, will not return to the school until cleared by the health department.

We have begun contact tracing and school administration will be reaching out to members of the school community who were in close contact with that individual, and will also advise on the need to quarantine and to facilitate testing of those potentially exposed. It has been verified that safety protocols were in place and being followed, minimizing risks of exposure.

The exposure happened at Curry Road in Classroom 13. Wildwood School will continue to be open, utilizing our Hybrid 1 model, with the exception of this classroom and all individuals that are quarantined. Classroom 13 students will return to school on Monday, February 1, 2021, unless otherwise notified. **Parents will be contacted directly by the School Administration. School CSE's and School Transportation Companies, will receive a separate email if you have a student in this class and is affected by the quarantine.**

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information regarding positive cases or mandatory quarantine.
