

Dear Wildwood School Community and School Districts,

Today, Sunday, March 28, 2021, Wildwood was informed and confirmed that a staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual who tested positive and those who were exposed, will not return to the school until cleared.

We have begun contact tracing and school administration will be reaching out to members of the school community who were in close contact with that individual, and will also advise on their need to quarantine and be tested.

The exposure happened at Curry Road in Classroom 6 on March 24, 2021. Wildwood School will continue to be open, in our Hybrid 1 model, with the exception of this classroom and all individuals that are quarantined. Classroom 6 students will return to school on Monday, April 12, 2021.

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information regarding positive cases or mandatory quarantine.
