

Dear Wildwood School Community and School Districts,

Today, Tuesday, April 20, 2021, Wildwood School was informed and confirmed that a staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual who tested positive and those who were exposed, will not return to the school until cleared.

We have begun contact tracing and school administration will be reaching out to families and school staff, who were in close contact with that individual, and will also advise on their need to quarantine and be tested.

The exposure happened at Curry Road in classrooms 7 and classroom 12. Wildwood School will continue to be open, in our Hybrid 1 model, with the exception of these classrooms and all individuals that are quarantined. ***School district CSE's and Transporters will receive a separate email with specific student names from your district, who were affected by the exposure.***

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information regarding positive cases or mandatory quarantine.
