

Good morning,

Yesterday afternoon the Schenectady City School District informed us that there were two bus staff, working on two separate buses, who tested positive for COVID-19.

The Schenectady City School District has been working with the Schenectady County Department of Health to inform the parents of the students on those buses that they are being placed on a mandatory quarantine. They are also contacting the Durham Transportation Company so that these students are not transported to school during the quarantine period.

Currently, these students are considered contacts of the positive person. Anyone who the students have been in contact with are considered to be at very minimal risk but parents should always monitor their children for any related symptoms, take standard pandemic precautions and contact their health care professional if their child has symptoms or feels ill.

We will continue to share information as we have it.
